Treatments Address Urinary Incontinence

The involuntary loss of urine, urinary incontinence, affects twice as many women as men thanks to the impact of pregnancy, childbirth and menopause, on the bladder, urethra, and other muscles that support these organs.

It can range from slightly bothersome (loss of a few drops of urine while running or coughing) to debilitating (loss of a large amount of urine with little or no warning thereby keeping women from leaving home). Pelvic organ prolapse – when the bladder drops from its normal spot – is often linked to strain during childbirth or following hysterectomy.

Your Desert West Obstetrics & Gynecology provider has a number of options to treat urinary incontinence. These can range from lifestyle changes and medications to an in-home therapy device or bladder leakage/sling procedure.
