Keeping Up with Vaginal Infections -

Burning, itching, and an unpleasant odor are some of the common symptoms of vaginal infections. Treatments vary by condition, so it's important to know which type of infection you have.


A normal, healthy vagina contains bacteria and sometimes yeast without necessarily having an infection. But things such as hormone level changes, taking antibiotics, chronic high blood sugar, pregnancy and douching can change the environment in the vagina, enabling bacterial or yeast overgrowth causing symptoms.

The three most common types of vaginal infections:

- I. Yeast infections can cause vaginal itching, redness of the vulva and may include a thick, white discharge.
- 2. Bacterial vaginosis symptoms can include a thick or whitish discharge or one that is slippery and clear. It is not likely to itch or burn.
- 3. Trichomoniasis, a sexually transmitted infection, has symptoms similar to other vaginal infections: burning, irritation, redness, and swelling of the vulva, with a yellow-gray or greenish vaginal discharge.
